

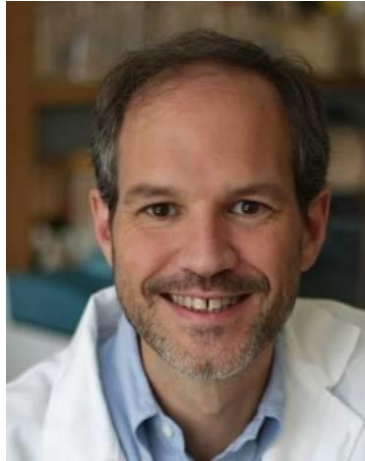

Heterogeneity of Memory B Cells: the long and short of it

Abstract: I will cover three related topics. First, I will describe the definition and then function of novel subsets of murine memory B cells. Then I will discuss what controls the differential formation of memory B cells and plasma cells during a T cell dependent immune response; I will also discuss the formation of memory B cell subsets. Finally, I will talk about how a pathogen alters greatly the B cell immune response, with specific reference to Salmonella infections.
