- Communication and enforcement of laboratory safety procedures.
- Algal culture stock maintenance and assistance with sample archiving, both of physical samples in freezers and metadata associated with samples on online databases.

## Job Requirements:

- A Bachelor's degree in biology, molecular biology, marine science or a related field. Graduate degree in life, earth or environmental science an advantage.
- At least 2 years of experience in laboratory work with knowledge of techniques in molecular biology and microbiology. Experience in biogeochemistry, biological oceanography and 'Omics tools (e.g. metabarcoding, metagenomics and transcriptomics) an advantage.
